

MINUTES OF THE CITY COUNCIL, VICTOR, IOWA, FEBRUARY 7, 2008

The city council met in regular session at city hall at 7:00 P.M. Present were council members Cavin, Faga, Robinson, and Simmons. DeNeve was absent. Mayor Roger Pawlak called the meeting to order.

Bill Lynch, HLV School superintendent, met with the council. The school will be constructing a building addition this summer. A city water main will need to be moved. The council and the superintendent informally agreed to a cost-sharing of moving the water main.

Motion Faga, second Cavin to approve the HLV building permit for the school building addition. Aye: Cavin, Faga, Robinson, and Simmons. Nay: none. Motion carried.

Sarah Bixby, director of the South Central Iowa Solid Waste Agency, met with the council. She explained that tipping fees at the Poweshiek County Transfer Station are more than the tipping fees at the Iowa County. However, the per capita fee charged to the city by Poweshiek County is less than the fee that would be charged by Iowa County. The city currently uses the Poweshiek County Transfer Station. Ms. Bixby explained that overall, the city pays less cost to use the Poweshiek County Transfer Station than the city would pay at the Iowa County Landfill.

Motion Faga, second Cavin to set a public hearing for March 6, 2008 at 7:00 P.M. at city hall on the proposed 2008-2009 city budget. Aye: Cavin, Faga, Robinson, and Simmons. Nay: none. Motion carried.

Motion Faga, second Cavin to approve renewal of D&P's liquor license. Aye: Cavin, Faga, Robinson, and Simmons. Nay: none. Motion carried.

Motion Faga, second Robinson to approve the minutes from January 10 and January 28, 2008 meetings, and the investment report for January. Aye: Faga, Cavin, Robinson, Simmons. Nay: none. Motion carried.
