

MINUTES OF THE CITY COUNCIL, VICTOR, IOWA, MAY 15, 2008

The city council met in regular session at city hall at 7:00 P.M. Present were council members Cavin, Faga, Simmons, Robinson. DeNeve was absent. Mayor Roger Pawlak called the meeting to order.

The city council held a public hearing on Mike Read's request to build a garage addition at 406 Lincoln Street closer to the lot line than allowed by the ordinance. No comments were received. Motion Simmons, second Cavin to approve the building permit application. Aye: Cavin, Faga, Simmons, Robinson. Nay: none. Motion carried.

Bob Dentel presented a building permit application for a garage at 535 Harrison Street. The council must approve an exception to the restricted residence district ordinance before the application can be approved since the garage will not be in connection with a residence. Motion Faga, second Simmons to set a public hearing on the building permit application for June 12, 2008 at 7:00 P.M. at city hall. Aye: Cavin, Faga, Simmons, Robinson. Nay: none. Motion carried.

Greg DeBrower explained plans for 8 Rolle Bolle courts at the south city park. Motion Robinson, second Simmons for the city to pay \$500 toward construction of the courts. Aye: Cavin, Faga, Simmons, Robinson. Nay: none. Motion carried.

There has been a drainage problem in the farm field southwest of the closed bridge at the east/north end of 1st Street. The problem may result from a field drain tile plugged from debris dumped near the bridge by the city. The city may pay some of the cost to open the plugged tile.
