

MINUTES OF THE CITY COUNCIL, VICTOR, IOWA, JUNE 12, 2008

The city council met in regular session at city hall at 7:00 P.M. Present were council members Cavin, Faga, Simmons, Robinson, and DeNeve was absent. Mayor Roger Pawlak called the meeting to order.

The city council held a public hearing on Bob Dentel's request to build a garage at 535 Harrison Street. Comments were received concerning water draining and access to the property.
