

MINUTES OF THE CITY COUNCIL, VICTOR, IOWA, AUGUST 28, 2008

The city council met at city hall at 7:00 P.M. Present were council members Cavin, Faga, Simmons, Robinson, and DeNeve. Mayor Roger Pawlak called the meeting to order.

The council held a public hearing on James Weiermann's application for a special building permit for a house addition extending south from the present structure at 408 4th Street. Notice of the public hearing was published on August 20, 2008. No comments were received. The council had a concern about the current location of a fence on the property close to the sidewalk.

Motion Faga, second DeNeve to approve the special building permit. Aye: Faga, DeNeve, Cavin. Nay: Robinson, Simmons. Motion denied because the ordinance requires a yes vote from 4 of the 5 council members.

Motion Faga, second DeNeve to approve the special building permit on the condition that Mr. Weiermann move the fence back 8 feet from the sidewalk and even with the house addition. Aye: Faga, DeNeve, Simmons, Cavin. Nay: Robinson. Special permit approved with conditions.

Motion DeNeve, second Cavin to approve a cigarette permit and a beer, wine, and Sunday sales permit for Casey's. Aye: DeNeve, Cavin, Simmons, Faga, Robinson. Nay: none. Motion carried.

The council discussed various nuisance concerns in the city and parking concerns at the school.

Meeting adjourned at 7:30 P.M.
