

MINUTES OF THE CITY COUNCIL, VICTOR, IOWA, JANUARY 15, 2009

The city council met in regular session at city hall at 7:00 P.M. Present were council members Cavin, Faga, Simmons, Robinson, and DeNeve. Mayor Roger Pawlak was absent. Mayor pro-tem Faga called the meeting to order.

Val Hansen, library board president, and Tiffany Lynn, library director, gave the annual library report. Elaine Roberts has retired as library director. She will continue to work at the library. Budget request from the city for 2009-2010 is \$25,000.

Wendy Roberts and Everett Iburg gave the annual cemetery report. Budget request from the city for 2009-2010 is \$5,000.

Motion DeNeve, second Simmons, to approve the first reading of Ordinance 306, AN ORDINANCE FOR A STOP SIGN AND NO PARKING AREA. The proposed ordinance provides for a four way stop at 5th and Main streets, and no parking on the east side of Main Street between 4th and 5th streets. Aye: Faga, Cavin, Robinson, DeNeve, Simmons.
