

MINUTES OF THE CITY COUNCIL, VICTOR, IOWA, JUNE 11, 2009

The city council met in regular session at city hall at 7:00 P.M. Present were council members Cavin, Robinson, Simmons, DeNeve and Faga. Mayor Roger Pawlak called the meeting to order.

Scott Morrow requested that the city charge him one sewer charge per apartment building, and not per occupant.

Brien Michalek requested permission to put a trash can and benches and do some landscaping by the rolle bolle courts. Motion Simmons, second Cavin to approve the proposal and to install an electric outlet. Aye: Cavin, Robinson, Simmons, DeNeve, Faga. Nay: none. Motion carried.

Sheri Rice from USDA talked with the council about low interest loan programs for day care facilities. Victor's average family income is too high for grant money.

Motion Simmons, second Robinson to approve the third reading of ORDINANCE 312, AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING ON THE STREET AFTER A SNOWFALL. Aye: Cavin, Robinson, Simmons, DeNeve, Faga. Nay: none. Motion Faga, second DeNeve to ask for an extension of time on the housing rehabilitation grant program, and to approve the quarterly report for the program. Aye: Cavin, Robinson, Simmons, DeNeve, Faga. Nay: none. Motion carried.

Motion Cavin, second Robinson to approve cigarette permits for Casey's, Victor's Market, D&P. Aye: Cavin, Robinson, Simmons, DeNeve, Faga. Nay: none. Motion carried.

Motion Faga, second Simmons to approve the minutes from May 14, and the investment report for May. Aye: DeNeve, Robinson, Cavin, Simmons, Faga. Nay: none. Motion carried.

Motion Faga, second Cavin to pay the following bills. Aye: Robinson, Cavin, Simmons, DeNeve (abstain on his bill for the park), Faga. Nay: none. Motion carried.
