

MINUTES OF THE CITY COUNCIL, VICTOR, IOWA, AUGUST 13, 2009

The city council met in regular session at city hall at 7:00 P.M. Present were council members Cavin, Robinson, Simmons, DeNeve and Faga. Mayor Roger Pawlak called the meeting to order.

AJ Schnebbe discussed library park issues with the council: emptying of trash cans; finances; equipment maintenance; rental policy. Orville Bloethe has given stock to the city having a value of approximately \$14,500. This is to cover the remainder of the new park expense, and to pay for one decorative light pole. Motion Faga, second Robinson to sell the stock and apply the proceeds of sale to the park and the light fixture project. Aye: Cavin, Robinson, Simmons, DeNeve, Faga. Nay: none. Motion carried.

The council discussed water, dirt, rock runoff at the south end of Harrison Street. The property owners to the south do not want anything put on their land to help control the water runoff. The cost to pave the south end of Harrison Street "to the fence" is in the \$19,500 to \$25,000 range. Also, paving would require the city to move a sewer line. The council will investigate further on the costs and options.

Judy Simmons explained that there is \$1,500 profit from the Victor Fun Days car show. She offered the money to the city to assist in making the city hall restroom handicapped accessible. Judy will get an estimate of cost for the project and meet with the council later.

Motion DeNeve, second Faga to approve the first reading of ordinance 314, AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE SEWER RENTAL RATE FOR MULTIPLE FAMILY DWELLINGS. Aye: Cavin, Robinson, Simmons, DeNeve, Faga. Nay: none. Motion carried.
