The city council met in regular session at city hall at 5:15 P.M. Present were council members Cavin, Robinson, DeNeve, Weiermann, and Faga. Mayor Roger Pawlak called the meeting to order.

Gary Edwards from the board of the East Central Iowa Council On Governments explained the Local Housing Trust Fund Program. The council will talk more about the topic at the March meeting.

Bert Guthrie received \$6,480 overpayment in connection with his work on the city's housing rehabilitation program. He is now retired and without significant financial means to repay the money.
