

MINUTES OF THE CITY COUNCIL, VICTOR, IOWA, AUGUST 15, 2012

The city council met in regular session at city hall at 7:00 P.M. Present were council members Faga, Smith, Robinson, Cavin, and Sternhagen. Mayor Roger Pawlak was absent. Mayor pro tem Faga called the meeting to order.

Duke Wilgenbusch discussed plans for decorative street lighting along Washington Street between 3rd Street and the railroad tracks, and on 2nd Street from Washington to Main. The city will submit a \$25,000 grant application to Prairie Meadows in September. Duke asked that the city provide \$35,000 toward the project. Total estimated cost of the project is \$70,000.

Motion Sternhagen, second Smith to approve the three year law enforcement contract with the Iowa County Sheriff at an annual cost of \$94,859, with before and after school patrol, and with a quarterly report on the number and kinds of law enforcement calls in the city. Aye: Faga, Smith, Cavin, Sternhagen. Nay: Robinson. Motion carried.

The council discussed problems with the disaster warning sirens in the city.
